a) **Days of Noah.** The “*days of Noah*” will prevail just before our Lord returns: “*And GOD saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually*” (Gen 6:5).

b) **Days of Lot.** “*Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot; they did eat, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they builded;: But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed them all*” (Luke 17:28, 29).

Today’s society is a “*re-run*” of the society of Sodom whose people were “*sex mad*” – everybody did just “*what comes naturally*” – which means “*whatever you please,*” carnally, sexually, homosexually, what is pleasing to the “*lust of the flesh.*”

“*Even thus shall it be in the day when the Son of man is revealed*” (Luke 17:30), On Sentosa it shall be enacted.

c) **Scoffers everywhere – the third sure sign.** The apostle Peter says, “*Knowing this first, that there shall come in the last days scoffers, walking after their own lusts, And saying, Where is the promise of his coming? for since the fathers fell asleep, all things continue as they were from the beginning of the creation*” (2 Pet 3:3,4).

Scoffers are a major feature of the end time. Men (and women) shall say, “*Life has never been so good, so exciting and pleasurable! It’s ‘business as usual.’*” So true!

Just as God’s Word predicted, so it will be. “*Go on with you, don’t spoil our fun!*” Scoffers everywhere cannot, will not, heed the Gospel warning, until the last judgment descends. Then too late!

3. What is ahead?

Some readers, at this point, will say, “*No need to tell us: we know all about it!*” You think

so? Don’t be so sure. Listen to the Word of God which describes the reaction of scoffers, unbelievers, and all those who poke fun at the “*last days doomsayers*” (meaning people like us in Pandan).

On that day, when our Lord shall be revealed from heaven, then wonders of wonders, the unthinkable happens: The Lord descends from heaven, and all the scoffers and the “*big shots*” wake up from their vain slumber.

“*And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains; And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb: For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?*” (Rev 6:15-17).

4. Final warning from Heaven

To all who read, including those who are enjoying the pleasures of sin “*for a season,*” thrilling to the “*... lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life ...*” I say lovingly, “*Awake! For why will ye die?*” Why exchange the salvation grace of God for the pleasures of sin which captivate but for “*a season*”?

But God’s salvation, purchased for you by the Son of God on Calvary’s cross is for ever, and ever – never ending and never fading!

Young people, the Authorities are alarmed because of social consequences. May God’s Spirit awaken and alarm you – those who are attracted by the pleasures of sin – return to the God of your eternal salvation!

more than lovers of God, so said the Apostle Paul.

The fact is what God’s Word predicted 2,000 years ago is happening before our eyes. Only the spiritually blind do not see, and the slumbering ones are not alarmed. The end time slumber of death is upon us!

My dear readers,

1. The Authorities are concerned

But the people were only enjoying themselves! This week-end the pleasure-loving crowds flocked to Pulau Sentosa (“*Isle of Peace*”) by the tens of thousands, like ants attracted to sugar! “*Lovers of pleasure more than lovers of God*” (2 Tim 3:4). Little wonder, SGBF attendance was slashed by a good half, almost.

You ask, “*Why are the Authorities alarmed?*” Last week, on 9 February, front page headlines of “*Straits Times*” carried the news: “*Schoolgirls aged 12 – 14 are having sex, a trend that is likely to continue.*” Alarm bells! Just as God’s Word foretold. The trend is on: “*... in the last days perilous times shall come. For men shall be lovers of their own selves,*”

2. These are sure signs of the “end times”

We have warned so often, it sounds like “*cry wolf*” without substance. When we remind readers of our Lord’s imminent return, some think it’s a big joke. God forbid that any in Pandan should be skeptical and unbelieving. The warning signs are for all to see. We recall three signs, sure and certain, unmistakable.

Would Satan ever tell the truth? If he could, what does one do with such a person? There was an incident in the Bible whereby such an event actually happened. **Acts 16:16-18** (KJV), "*And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying: 17 The same followed Paul and us, and cried, saying, These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation. 18 And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.*" The "we" in verse 16 refers to the apostle Paul, Silas, young Timothy and Luke the physician who was also the author of the Book of Acts. They were on their way to pray when a certain damsel, who was possessed with an evil spirit of divination met them. She was used by her master to make money, through her ability to tell the future.

At that very moment, the damsel who followed Paul and his companions cried these words, "*These men are the servants of the most high God, which shew unto us the way of salvation.*" She kept doing this for many days. The statement she said was true. Paul and his companions were really servants of the most high God. Their mission was also true for they all came to show the way of salvation. However, the apostle Paul was grieved by her behaviour. The word for "grieve" means a heightened sense of sorely troubled. It describes a person who had toiled long hours

through a difficult matter. In other words, what the damsel did by her perpetual proclamation troubled the apostle Paul greatly. The question is why? The damsel was not lying - she was telling the truth. One would expect the apostle Paul to be very happy with her proclamation of God's truth! Instead, Paul was worried and very upset by her remarks, all the more so because they were true!

The Context — The damsel was possessed by evil spirit of divination. She was used by masters for gain by her soothsaying. She kept on proclaiming the truth about Paul and his companions and the truth of their mission.

The Explanation – The issue is one of association. The apostle was not angry with the damsel because she told the truth, otherwise, he would have corrected her. He was upset that others might associate her and her masters, who made use of her for filthy lucre, with the apostle Paul and his companions. Paul and his companions were doing God's work and will. They were servants of God, whereas the damsel was a servant of Satan because of her demonic possession. The fact that her masters made money out of her was not only sinful and wicked, that association might jeopardize Paul's entire ministry! He and his companions could be seen as mercenaries very much like the damsel's masters selling the Gospel of Christ for money! These were very serious sins and could very well hinder the ministry of Christ in that city.

Paul had no choice but to cast the demon out of the damsel. The evil spirit came out of her immediately. Not only must the doctrines we preach and teach be true, our association must also be God-honouring. The source from which the truth originates must be God and His holy and perfect Word. This is the practice of Biblical Separation.

The Application – When pastors who compromise the truth by their sins preach the truth, they become very dangerous to the cause of Christ. When their sins are exposed, their entire ministry is rejected in totality. The truth they preach is also rejected as false. For example, a fundamentalist pastor cannot accept an invitation to preach the Gospel of Christ in a liberal or modernist church that either believes in limited inerrancy and infallibility of Scriptures or rejects the deity or humanity of Christ or the miracles of the Bible. To accept the invitation would send the wrong signals to his church members and becomes an endorsement of the errors of the liberal church.

Many pastors play down this important truth of proper and Christ-honouring association. They would simply join hands because of a common enemy. Such alliances which are not based upon God's truth and God Himself are sins in the sight of God. The group that thinks like this is the neo-evangelicals. This term was coined by Dr Harold Ockenga in a public speech that he made in 1948 in Fuller Theological Seminary. Today Fuller Seminary is one of the main headquarters of neo-evangelical teachings. Ockenga said that he believed in infiltration rather than biblical separation.

Today neo-evangelicalism has come a very long way. It is not a denomination but a movement. As such it has infiltrated into the hearts and minds of many Christians who belong to fundamental churches. How is that possible, you may ask? It is possible because neo-evangelicalism is a mind-set. It is a decision to preach the gospel without discernment. That makes it very appealing to the common Christian. The mindset is that as long as the gospel is preached, it does not matter who we are associated with!

Preaching the gospel is not the most important thing in the world for the believer. The most important thing to every believer is to glorify God. Preaching the gospel is one of the many ways the Christian can glorify God. How we preach the gospel and who we preach with are just as important as preaching the right gospel! Therefore, when Satan preaches the truth - beware!

Praise the Lord we do have \$ to buy them but I don't like to waste the funds we have been given. Maybe S'pore would be cheaper, but will I have time to get them done? We are asking the Lord to help us to be able to take time off school to come to camp. Grace will have Uni exams and Ruth has her Yr 12 trials, so it will be disruptive for her if we go away. DV Mrs Talbot will be well by then and she can board over in Wagga for the 2 weeks. Sorry to ramble. here are Joy's updates.

#3 Update from Joy Clements in Nairobi, Kenya**

Hi mum,

The building program you asked about is still at a standstill. The local council won't give the Centre a building permit unless they receive a bribe- which Christina is (of course) refusing to pay. Please pray particularly for this situation as it looks like it will take a miracle to get permission from this corrupt council to build the new facilities!

Both pastors seem to be doing well. They assist Christina by translating, counselling, teaching, leading daily devotions and weekly assemblies as well as running errands on behalf of the school nearly every day. Chloe and I are getting on well with both of them and enjoy their respective sense of humour! Pastor M. is married with no children, while Pastor W. has a wife and 7 children living 'up-country' on their family farm. (This separation of families is quite a common occurrence in Kenya since the men can often only find work if they move away from their families.) Consequently, Pastor W. only gets to see his family occasionally -which must be tough for him and his family- so this would also be another good point to pray about.

Christina is an extremely hardworking and efficient person so please do pray that we can be a blessing and of assistance to her without slowing her down.

There are many people whom Christina helps and occasionally it is discovered (sometimes years later) that a few of these people have not quite told the truth about their circumstances. Christina goes through intensive questioning processes with these people, makes home visits and often gets to know the families quite well so it must be tough for her when she finds out someone has willfully deceived her. There is one such case unfolding at the present time in which a boy whom Christina has helped significantly appears to have lied about the fact that he does have a father who is alive. This boy still has a mother dying of AIDS and very little money but the deception is still quite upsetting. I'm not sure exactly which case of being let down you were referring to in your email because it seems to happen fairly regularly so yes, please keep praying about these kinds of issues.

Thanks for the money sent to Christina- some of her supporters can be pretty irregular so I think she really appreciates the faithfulness of the Coota Fellowship in giving- even when it's small amounts!

Tomorrow Chloe and I will be running all the activities at the Thursday kids club- this includes games (for 100-150 kids), singing, a lesson, memory verse and craft! we are planning on doing a Jungle Doctor story using puppets and concentrating on the theme- "Be sure your sins will find you out." Please pray for extra levels of energy and creativity for us tomorrow!!

We'll take care and God bless. I hope the school/daily commuting is working out ok!

#2 Update from Joy**

Hi Mum, thank you so much for sending those funds from Calvary Pandan through to Christina!

I wrote a big long email to Doc last night so I've copied and pasted part of it into this email to save me writing everything twice. Sorry if there's a bit of overlap with what I already told you!

Just to give you some idea of where we are working... Christina Eglinton runs an orphanage in Nairobi called Solidarity Child Rescue Centre. It has about 28 orphans. Christina also runs a primary school (located at the orphanage and attended by all the orphans) for about 150 additional children who are day pupils only. She also tries to provide school fee assistance to another 50 or so children who study at various high schools in Nairobi.
